

## Joining Kendal & Lakes Divers - Scuba diving

### What is it going to cost?

Our pricing structure includes the following elements and they need to be paid as you reach each stage in your training. Joining both the BSAC (the national governing body in the UK) and our local branch (the club levy). Theory training, Pool training, Open water training and equipment hire.

Your memberships of BSAC and Kendal Branch lasts a year and it is easily possible to complete 2 courses in that time as well as taking part in other club activities!

First thing to do is to Register your interest in BSAC and open an account! This part is free but is an important first step!

Go to <https://bsac.sport80.com> in your browser and click 'Create account'.

Fill out the short form, choose your password and then click 'Register'. The email you use is important – your membership is tied to your email – you can easily recover from a forgotten or changed password, but it needs HQ help if you then change your email.

### The next steps are done in the following order;

- Choose and pay for your annual BSAC membership
- Choose and pay your Club Levy. (That's the club part of the payment that we, your local branch, receive - different branches have different levies depending on the facilities they have to pay for.)
- Complete your medical declaration

### Let's get you joined up to both BSAC and your local branch, Kendal & Lakes.

- Go to your new BSAC account. <https://bsac.sport80.com> but this time 'log in' with your new password. Your user name is your email address.

- The first screen you are presented with is your Dashboard. Everything is done from here.
- On the left of your Dashboard you will see a button called 'View Profile'. Click on this.
- You see a new screen with a new menu to the left and your profile on the right. The word 'Profile' in the left hand menu is highlighted showing you are in your 'Profile' screen.

The profile screen shows details held about you and if you wish, you can click on 'Edit Profile' and go through the various screens adding details or editing anything that is wrong - at the foot of the screen you can hit 'Next' to see the following one. There is even a page asking how you like to be contacted and you have the opportunity to upload a photo. Don't forget to 'SAVE' any new info.

- On the left side of the screen there are various menu options and you need to set up your Individual membership and Club levy.
- Choose **Individual Membership** from the list of options. You can now '**Add Membership**'. From the drop down list select the appropriate one which is probably either **Full Club Member** or Student Diving Member. (If in doubt take advice from your branch first).
- Follow this through – from the drop down list of clubs choose Kendal & Lakes. Finish the screen and hit 'Save' or 'Add Membership'. You can also choose type of payment and it's a good idea to use a credit card. If you wish to use Direct Debit, you may, but this will delay your membership while it is being set up. Your membership selection will then be placed in your 'Basket' ready for payment.

### You can now set up the Club Levy

- From the list of menu options on the left, choose '**Club Levy**' - This will present the Club Levy screen.

**You now need to select 'Add Club Levy'. (Highlighted in blue). You will see something like this..**

Using the drop down menu, select either

**Standard Member, annual collection**

Or

**Standard Member 12 instalments if you wish to pay monthly.**

Then **'Save'**

You will now need to follow it through to your 'basket' and pay. Once that is verified, you will have sorted your membership.

**Once you have paid you are allocated a membership number**

**(Remember to pay for your basket!)**

**Now - you can set up your medical declaration**

- From the drop down menu on the left, select 'Medical Documentation'

Click on the link to the video showing you how to complete this section - however the example given is not really helpful!

- Click on 'Add Medical Documentation'
- Select 'Self Declaration Medical'
- Read the questions and make sure you can answer 'No' to all questions (If not then contact me for advice).
- Make sure you click the button **'None of the above apply to me'**

All medicals, documents and declarations are viewed by HQ staff - this usually takes a few hours.

Your medical declaration will now read 'Pending' and highlighted in orange.

Once it is checked by HQ, this will change to 'Current' and highlighted in Green.

You will receive an automatic reminder each year to complete a new medical declaration.

When you are joined as a BSAC member, your details will appear on our club management system and we can show you how to access your e\_learning course for the theory and we can plan your practical training.
